

Rules:

- One student picks a card out of the box or pile. They need to say and clap the rhythm on their card. If they do it correctly, they can keep the card and the next person gets a turn. If they say it incorrectly, they need to put the card back and then the next person gets a turn.
- If a student picks up a card with a sound effect on it, they have to put all their cards back in the box and then the next person gets a turn.
- The winner is the person who has the most cards when you call "time." Typically, I tell them to finish the round and then count their cards to discover who is the winner. Some groups will have ties and both of them will be winners.

Variations:

- Try mixing it up after the first round - have them switch groups.
- Have them review with a lower level set of cards and then move up to the current grade level of cards.
- Have them clap without saying the rhythm.
- Have a fellow student decide whether they should clap it, say it, or both.
